Ross Harrison is a Professor in the School of Foreign Service at Georgetown University. He also serves as a Professor of Political Science at the University of Pittsburgh, and as a non-resident scholar at The Middle East Institute. In addition, Mr. Harrison annually teaches a course on strategy and international security to senior Georgian government officials at the Georgian Foundation for Strategic and International Studies in Tbilisi, Georgia. He is the author of a number of publications including, "Strategic Thinking in 3D: A Guide for National Security, Foreign Policy and Business Professionals." Mr. Harrison is a frequent lecturer and has spoken at the U.S. Department of State, the National War College and National Defense University, Georgetown University, and the Matthew B. Ridgway Center for International Security Studies.
